

Curriculum vitae

Rev. Dr Emmanuel Papamikroulis was born in Athens, Greece in 1983. He received his High School Diploma from the Patriarchal School of Crete in 2001. In 2007 he received a Bachelor Degree in Theology from the Faculty of Theology of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. From 2007 until 2012 he followed the II and III cycle of Studies in the Faculty of Oriental Canon Law at the Pontifical Oriental Institute (Rome), as a scholarship holder of the Dicastery for Promoting Christian Unity, and received a Licentiate and Doctorate in Oriental Canon Law.

In 2019 he was ordained deacon and priest. He is the author of various scientific journal articles and dictionary entries in the field of Eastern Canon Law. From academic year 2022-23, he teaches Canon Law at the Theological Institute of the Archdiocese of the Ecumenical Patriarchate in Italy “Saint Eufemia of Calcedonia”.

From 2013, he has been working at the Synodical Committee of Inter-Orthodox and Inter-Christian Relations of the Church of Greece. On 2 November 2023, he was nominated, under a decision of the Holy Synod of the Church of Greece, Secretary of the Synodical Committee of Inter-Orthodox and Inter-Christian Relations. He was member of the Delegation of the Church in Greece at the Holy and Great Council of the Orthodox Church (Crete 2016). A member of the delegation of the Church of Greece at the 11th World Council of Churches Assembly (Karlsruhe 2022) and he also participated as a delegate at the 2023 Conference of European Churches General Assembly in Tallinn.
